**WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ACADEMIC  
CAMP AND ENRICHMENT CAMP?**

**Academic Camp is for Reading & Math Intervention**

- Each trimester all students are tested on state indicators in reading & math. Students scoring in the lowest quintile (20%) are invited to Academic Camp for extra time and alternate methods to become proficient in the current trimesters indicators. When extra seats are available, students who could benefit from intervention are invited.
- Test scores & Camp invitations are sent home via student backpacks the last week of the trimester.
- Students are retested at the end of camp to measure their growth.
- Limited transportation will be provided. Call the school to be considered for one of the 13 available spots. The school will call to confirm selection.
- FREE breakfast and lunch provided.
- Winter Camp is Feb. 23—Mar. 2nd; 8:30 am—12:30 pm

**Enrichment Camp is for Inspiration**

- Special workshops are offered to provide challenge and inspire students in areas of their aptitude and interests.
- No transportation provided by SAE.

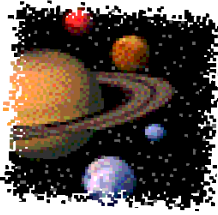
