School Dress Code

The dress code for the Springfield Academy of Excellence will consist of navy bottoms and white tops for all students in grades kindergarten through 5th. Middle school students' uniforms (6th grade) will consist of khaki bottoms and light blue tops. Uniforms must be worn **every school day**. This includes: Academic Camp, Field Trips, Picture Day, and all Special Program Days. If a student is not in uniform, a parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up their child(ren), take them home, change their clothes, and return them to school immediately.

All tops should have a collar such as a polo shirt or button down oxford. T-Shirts or undershirts are unacceptable. Students are not permitted to wear denim or jeans even if they are navy or khaki. Skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee. Shorts are permitted and must also be no shorter than two inches above the knee.

Body piercing is limited to ears only. Students may not wear pierced rings or studs on any other body part. **NOTE: NO heellie skate shoes, NO flip flops, NO purses in class, NO backpacks with wheels.**
